THE PRESENTATION

The Patron stands before the Bishop's representative and says: Mr Archdeacon, I present to you Michael Arthur Hill to be admitted to the cure of souls in this parish.

THE INDUCTION The Archdeacon, the Lay Chairman, the Incumbent and the Churchwardens move to the principal door of the church.

The Archdeacon lays the hand of the incumbent on the handle of the door and says:

> By virtue of this mandate, I induct you into the real and actual possession of this Parish Church of St Leonard, Chsham Bois with all the rights and responsibilities belonging to it.

The Incumbent tolls the bell.

The Incumbent leads the way to the font. All turn towards the font.

- 1st Churchwarden: "Jesus said: All authority in heaven and earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, make disciples of all the nations; baptise them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." Mt 28:18-19
- Lay Chairman: By the sacrament of baptism we enter into Christ's Church and are made members of his body. It is our calling to care for those who are baptised and together to live with Christ his risen life.
- Archdeacon: Priest and people, will you play your part in helping those, young and old, who become Christ's by baptism, to grow in faith, hope and love? Will you seek a greater unity with your fellow Christians? Will you obey the Lord in bringing his good news to all

Together: With God's help we will.

The Incumbent then leads the way to the chancel step, and turns to face the people.

2nd Churchwarden: "And to some his gift was that they should be apostles: to some prophets; to some evangelists; to some pastors and teachers; so that the saints together make a unity in the work of service, building up the body of Christ. Eph 4:11ff

- Chairman: "Jesus said, 'I am the bread of life. He who comes to Lay Chairman: me will never be hungry; he who believes in me will never thirst.' Jn 6:35
- Lay Chairman: It is the Priest's privilege and duty publicly to lead the people in the Church's worship and prayer, to preach the Gospel, to teach the Christian way of life and especially to celebrate the Eucharist with his people. By the sacrament of the Body and blood of Jesus Christ we have that communion with our Lord, which unites us with one another in the life and caring work of his Church.
- Archdeacon: deacon: Priest and people, it is only through our life in Christ that we draw strength for daily living. Will you pray constantly for one another and for the community which you are called to serve? Will you join together regularly in the Holy Communion so that you may grow together in holiness to share the work of ministry?

Together: With God's help we will.

The Archdeacon takes the Incumbent by the hand, places him in his stall, and says:

I place you in the stall of the Rector of this parish. The Lord guard you, body and soul, against all evil; preserve your going out and your coming in; and fill your heart with love and peace; now and always.

Together: Amen.

THE NUNC DIMMITTIS Lord now you let your servant go in peace: your word has been fulfilled. My own eyes have seen the salvation: which you have prepared in the sight of every people; A light to reveal you to the nations: and the glory of your people Israel.
