PARISH CHURCH OF CHESHAM BOIS
St. Leonard's

Founded in 1215 A.D. as a private Chapel to the Manor House.

Alterations and Extensions made in 1823—in 1881—in 1911—and in 1954.

There are many features of interest:—

A Queen Anne Holy Table.

A Jacobean Pulpit and iron holder for an Hour Glass.

An Elizabethan Chalice.

Monumental Brasses of 1542, one of them of a Chrysom Child.

An Altar Lamb 1585.

St. Leonard lived about 500 A.D.

He was a young Frankish Chief under King Clovis.

He became a hermit living in a forest in the South of France.

Escaped and rescued prisoners gathered in a colony around him.

He became the Patron Saint of prisoners.
