

Memorial Inscriptions of the Parish IV

Chesham Bois
Parochial Cemetery



These transcripts were compiled in July - October 1998 by Deborah Read and Colin Mills, with the kind permission of Chesham Bois Parish Council and the assistance of Mrs June Gossling, Parish Clerk. Chesham Bois One-Place Study was begun by Colin Mills in 1994, and briefly involves gathering every scrap of information about the parish, its records and its inhabitants. This is evidently an on-going project, but by the end of May 1999, 10,500 records from a variety of sources had been entered into a database. The entrance to the cemetery is at the bottom of a bridleway, near the bottom of the Jacobs Ladder footpath, which leads under a railway bridge onto Woodley Hill and Bois Moor Road. There are two large cast-iron gates for hearses, usually kept locked, and a small gate for pedestrians, all painted green. Inside the gate is a car park; on the left is the chapel, and on the right is a rose garden. The cemetery, with a path in the middle with trees and bushes on each side, continues up to the brow on the hill.

Plots have been recorded when there is some evidence of use, for example a mound, flowers, a sunken area, or a memorial, but when there is no gravestone it can be difficult to tell whether the plot has been used. While we transcribed the gravestones as carefully as possible in the circumstances, there are undoubtedly errors and omissions remaining: it has not yet proved possible to arrange for a team to check the transcript against the gravestones, and many inscriptions could not be read because the gravestones were overgrown or obscured by turf or anthills, or because the gravestones had fallen over, thus making them unreadable. It is hoped that a project can be arranged to clear the ivy and turf, remove the anthills and re-erect the gravestones. This project could include arrangements to check this transcript against the inscriptions.

The transcription begins on the left hand side, at the bottom by the chapel, working from the path to the hedge, continuing up the hill to the top hedge, and then begins again on the right hand side, at the bottom by the shed and the garden of remembrance, working from the path to the hedge and continuing up the hill to the top hedge. The rows are numbered from the bottom on both sides.
