
Chesham Bois One-Place Study

CHESHAM BOIS - MISCELLANEOUS MEMORIAL INSCRIPTIONS

Three-cornered plot between Annes Corner and Parish Centre

- Seat at junction of Glebe Way and North Road near Parish Centre black metal, no plaque or inscription.
- Seat on plot <u>opposite</u> bus stop at junction of Glebe Way, Bois Lane, South Road and Chestnut Lane white metal, no plaque or inscription.
- Seat near bus stop at junction of Glebe Way, Bois Lane, South Road and Chestnut Lane, opposite plot black metal, inscription reads: "Presented by Amersham West District Guides in 1985 to celebrate 75 years of Guiding".
- War memorial erected on corner of North Road and Bois Lane in 1920; names listed in order 4 of rank; extra inscription added on base in 1945, names listed in alphabetical order with rank. "Erected / to the memory / of those of this / parish who fell / in the Great War / 1914-18 // Capt. H. Gilmore Waghorn / Lieut. Cyril J.D. Clarke / Lieut. A.T. Crawford Cree / Lieut. Cecil W.N. Woodcock / 2nd Lt. Leonard Cox / 2nd Lt. J. Anthony Horne / 2nd Lt. Sidney L. Rose / Sgt. F. Parmenas Beckley / Sgt. Bert Benning / Sgt. William N. Edwards / Sgt. Albert G. Fenn / Sgt. Frederick C. Parish Centre

- Plaque on Parish Centre: brown material, inscription reads: "There is salvation in no one else, / for there is no other name / under heaven given / among men by which / we must be saved / but by the name of / JESUS CHRIST. Acts 4:12 / Let praises ring aloud this day / That Jesus' name has pow'r / to break apart the fearful chains / of sin that bind us. M.B.".
- Notice reading "St Leonards / Parish Centre / Caretaker Mrs M Honour / 58 St Leonards Road / Chesham Bois / tel. Amersham (01494) 725601 / Vehicles left at owners risk".
- Foundation stone to parish centre: "This stone was aid by / the Right Reverend the / Lord Bishop of Buckingham".
- Memorial plaque in extension: "St Leonards Parish Centre Extension / was opened by the Rt Rev Colin Bennetts / the Bishop of Buckingham / on Sunday 11th September 1994 // Do all for the Glory of God / 1 Corinthians 10: 31".
- Memorial plaque under clock in parish centre meeting room: "Presented by the morning / coffeee group / 1997 //// In memory of John Voss / chairman of the / hall committee / 1976 1980".

Wooden seat with, carved on top rail, "CBS"

Pioneer Hall

Wooden plaques: Pioneer Hall // Rebuilt / 1921

Bricky Pond area near Old Rectory

- Seat on North Road between Glebe Way near Bricky Pond, inscription reads: "Donated by Amersham International plc for the Neuroblastoma Society in support of children with cancer".
- Plaque at Bricky Pond, inscription reads: "This Pond was restored during 1996 / 97 by the Chesham Bois Pond Restoration Group in partnership with Chesham Bois Parish Council. Records show that there has been a pond on this site since at least 1735. The pond is believed to have been formed as a result of clay digging for brick manufacture. [Copious ecological notes and details of sponsorship, dated] August 1997.".

Chesham Bois Cricket Pitch

- Tree with plaque reading "British Oak / Planted in commemoration of the / 25th year of the reign of H.M. King George V / 6th May 1935".
- Tree with cast-iron fence and plaque reading "British Oak / Planted in commemoration / of the 25th year of the / reign of Her Majesty / Queen Elizabeth II / 6th February 1977".
- Tree with plaque reading "English Oak planted in commemoration of the Coronation of H.M. King George VI 12th May 1937".
- Tree with fence and plaque reading "Placed here by Chesham Bois Parish Council on 12th November 1994 as part of part of the Parish Council's centenary celebrations".
- 5-8 Seats (four) around pitch, black metal without plaque or inscription.
- 9 Seat, varnished wood and concrete without plaque or inscription.

Boundary posts - two small cast-iron plaques with "Chesham / 1934 / Urban District Council" south side of railway bridge at the bottom of Bois Lane leading to Bois Moor

2 on Amersham Road near Chesham town sign at edge of woods

Meadow between St Leonards Church, Bois Lane & High Bois

Tree plaque and fence: "Placed here by / Chesham Bois / Parish Council / on 12 November 1994 / as part of / the Parish Council / Centenary celebrations".

Seats with plaques:

- 2 In memory of Patrick Stanley / 1911 1993
- In memory of Miss E B Pemberton OBE / 1885 1994

Footpath leading to church from drive off Bois Lane leading to Chesham Bois House the Warren & Bois Wood Barns

Two electric lamp standards, second with plaque: "These lights were given by / Jackie Tagent in memory of her parents / Daphne and Lance Schofield / members of this church for 50 years / November 1991".

Henton Mission Room, Chiltern Open Air Museum

Portable harmonium behind communion rail with brass plate: "A Mothers Union Jubilee gift / to Chesham Bois parish / from the Branch Members / June 1926".
